Integrating the MeerKAT precursor into SKA Mid



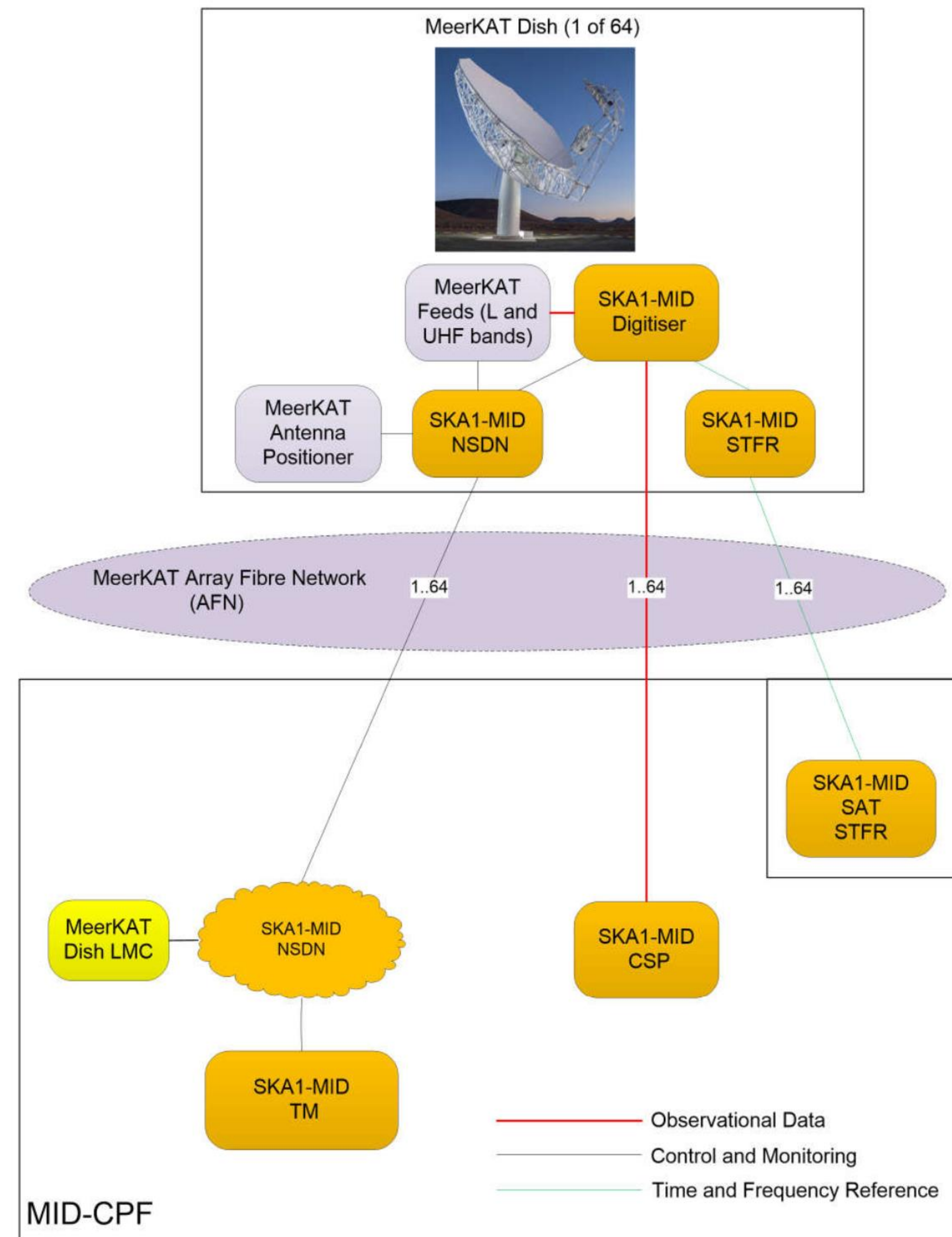

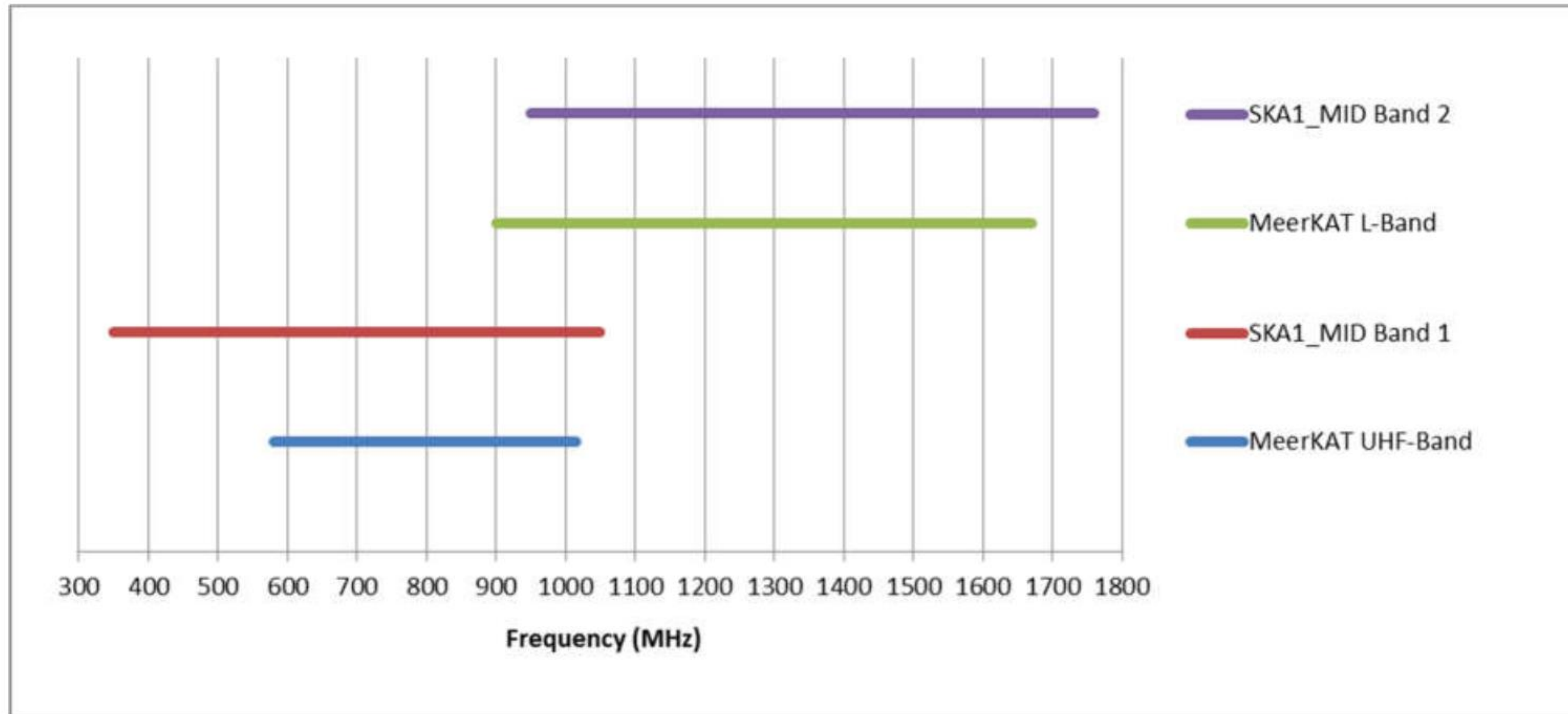
What is integrated?

- Retain MeerKAT Dish and Feeds
- Add SKA digitiser, SAT and NSDN to pedestal
- Re-use MK network Fibres
- All LMCs on one server in CPF communicating to 64 x Dish & Feed controllers

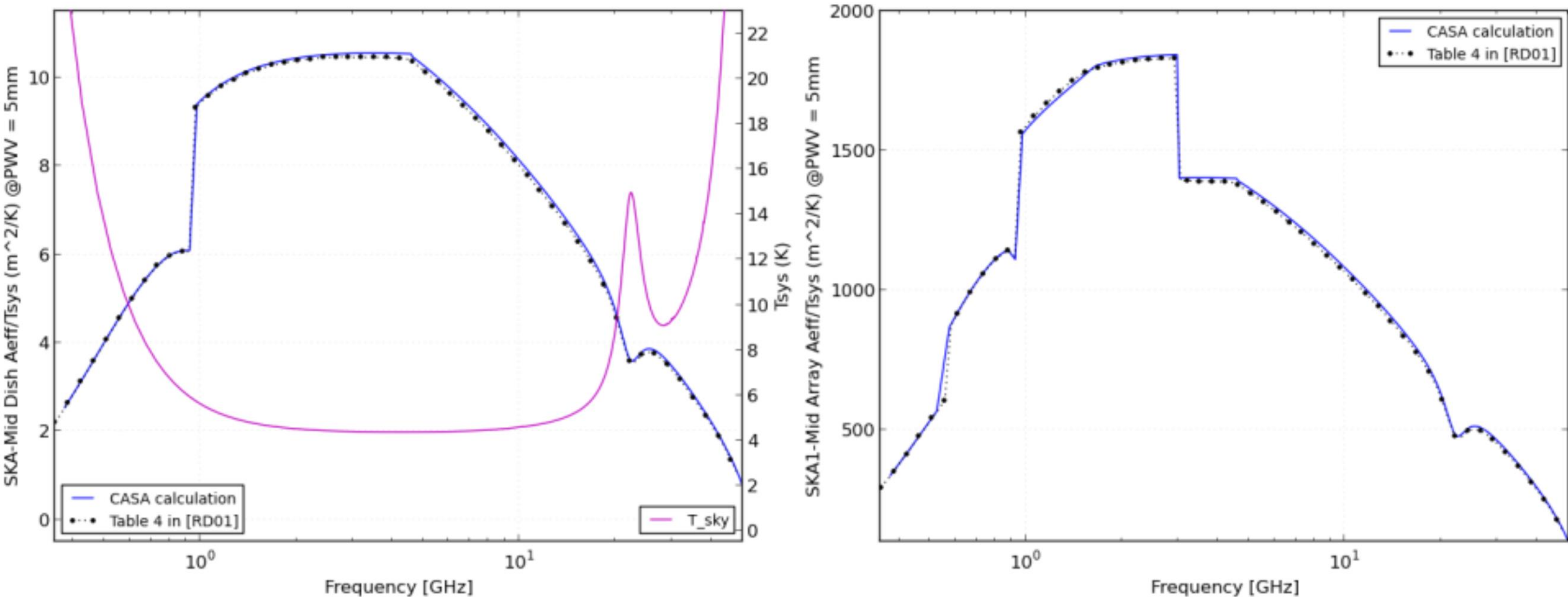
MeerKAT Bands after integration



- Use SKA SPFRx123 Digitiser
- Use MeerKAT UHF and L-Band feeds

Extended MeerKAT (MK+)

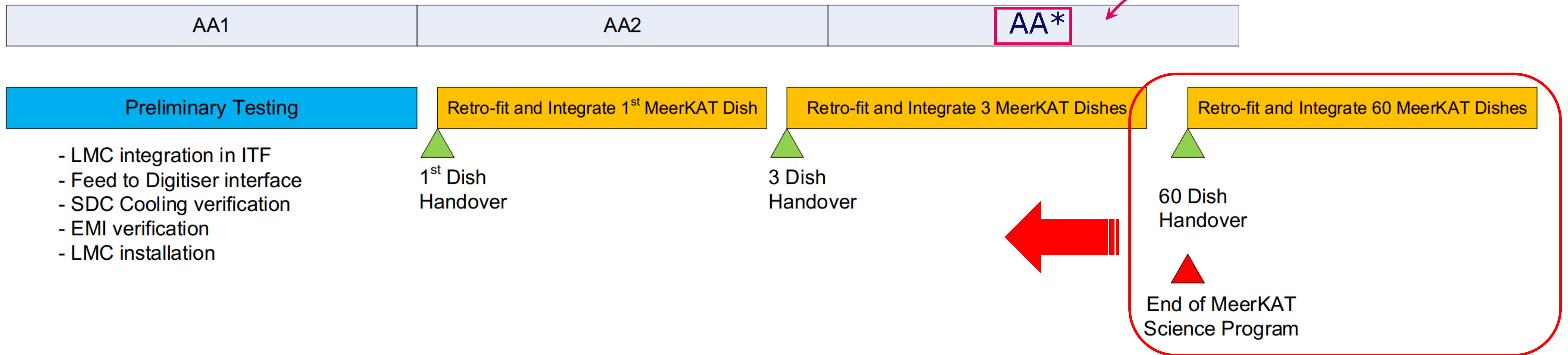
- SARA0 and MPI are extending the MeerKAT through the addition of 16 SKA Mid Dishes with Band 2 Feeds
- Located on SKA Mid Dish locations
- To be integrated fully into SKA Mid and retrofitted to be equivalent to an SKA Dish
- MK+ Dish Structure manufacture kicked off before SKA Dish CDR, & has other suppliers, so is a bit different
- Builds some of Mid Infrastructure, e.g. 20 of the 197 SKA Foundations



MK Integration into the Mid Array

- Separate MK Integration contract (Q4 2022)
- Each MK Dish to undergo Dish AIV process
- Qualify one conversion before doing the remainder
- Final schedule determined by SKA progress

+16x MK+ Dishes



Other MeerKAT interfaces

- SKA inherits engineering ops processes and records
- Power distribution, buildings and facilities
- Integrate their Masers into our SAT Timescale (without losing accurate timing to SKA operations!)
- Potential interference from working on their operational site (Tracey's talk)
- SOC, EOC and SPC (Tracey's talk)



SKA MeerKAT Programmatic Working Group (SMPWG)

- Series of engagement meetings between SARA0/SKAO:
 - Technical forums (e.g. SAT, RFI, Operations)
 - Co-ordination meetings (Site activities, SKA Programmes at SARA0)
- SMPWG Meeting once per quarter
 - Report back on the above meetings
 - Report on SKA Mid progress
 - MeerKAT and MeerKAT+ status and interfaces
 - Host country work
